- 2 Students (Miss Nirva Mavani(VIII) and Mast. Manya Belani (IX) secured 3<sup>rd</sup> position and received certificates.

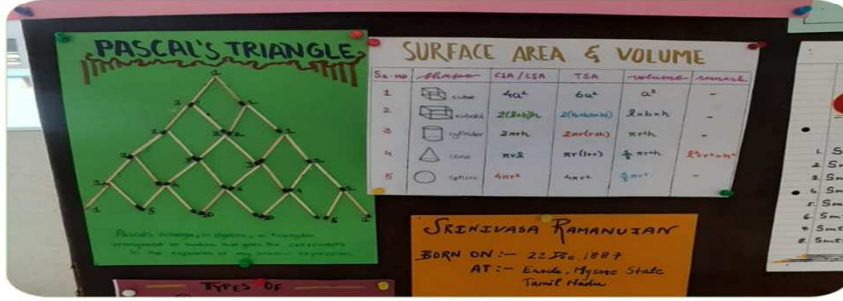
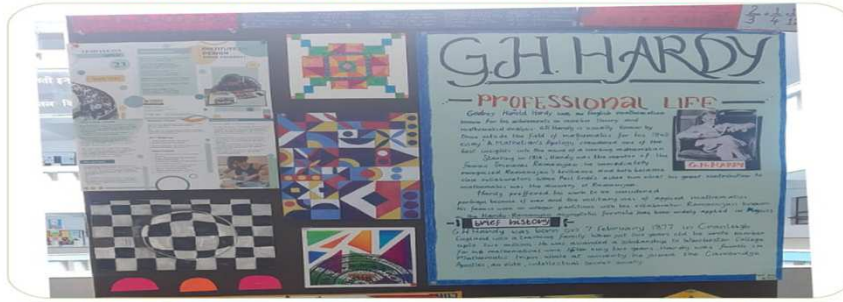
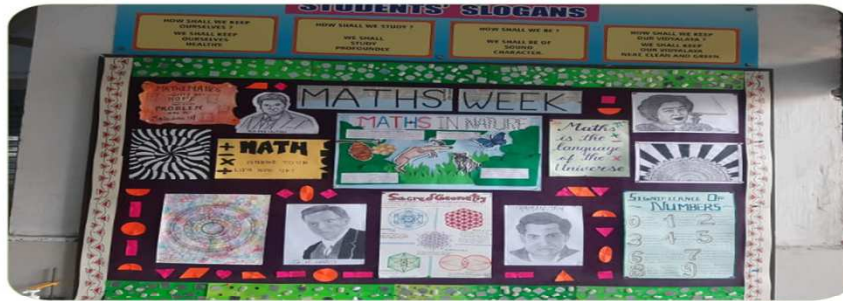
# DISASTER MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE
