

Mavians attend pariksha par charcha

Pariksha Pe Charcha, an initiative by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, which (he began in the year 2015) is an annual event. The objective of Pariksha Pe Charcha is to interact with students who aim to take their X or XII Board Examination in an academic year. In this programme he addresses issues related to stress, time management, peer pressure, parents' pressure, increasing competition in the world etc.

This year too, the Pariksha Pe Charcha programme was held on January 20, 2020. The preparation for this began when schools all over India were asked to participate in an activity in which students of class X and XII were asked to submit an essay on any topic - 'Grat-
